Greater Columbia Marine Foundation and Columbia Opportunity Resource Partner for One of the Midlands Largest Volunteer Engagement Efforts

September 25, 2012 - COLUMBIA, SC – Columbia Opportunity Resource (COR) and the Greater Columbia Marine Foundation have again joined forces to recruit more than 500 volunteers for the USMC Ultimate Challenge Mud Run Saturday, October 13, 2012 at Sandy Run. The USMC Mud Run, a bi-annual event, raises money for the families of Marines who have been injured or killed in action and funds scholarships in memory of Marines who gave their lives defending our freedom. The USMC Mud Run is one the largest single-day volunteer recruitment efforts in the Midlands. Volunteers are needed to support 9,000+ runners completing the 5.2-mile all-terrain course, a series of 36 boot camp styled obstacles that have been surrounded by (or consist entirely of) mud. While Marines are stationed along the course, civilian volunteers help with a variety of activities from the course registration to the finish line.

All volunteers will receive a free lunch or dinner depending on their shift, a free t-shirt and an invitation to the volunteer appreciation after-party. Volunteers must be at least 13 years or older (with ages 13-17 accompanied by an adult). Groups are encouraged to participate in the USMC Mud Run.
